



# art in ketchum

The City of Ketchum has been named one of the top 12 small towns for art in the U.S. by ArtPlace. We have Art on Fourth, a series of sculptures along one of the town's major streets; Cover Art on utility boxes; StreetArt on manhole covers; artworks by local artists in City Hall; and various outdoor sculptures owned by the city. All projects were organized by the Ketchum Arts Commission (KAC).

## ART ON FOURTH:

This juried annual outdoor exhibition, curated by the KAC, is now in its sixth year and lines the Fourth Street Heritage Corridor. This year's exhibit features six works by four regional artists and will be in place until October.

## COVER ART:

Cover Art was unveiled in 2012 and features vinyl images of original art wrapped around utility boxes in Ketchum's downtown core. Six Idaho artists, supported by local sponsors, created vibrant, unique artwork to help transform otherwise mundane and utilitarian infrastructure. The project is expanding to include a Sun Valley Company gondola car that will be in Town Square this summer and then added to the lifts on Baldy for ski season.

## COMMUNITY ART:

Several generous donors have given outdoor sculptures that are installed in local parks and on sidewalks. In one instance, the KAC helped organize and design a new park by the YMCA that features the work of Ketchum native Rod Kagan, an internationally known artist who passed away in 2010.

## STREETART:

In 2011, the designs of several local artists were selected for commemorative coins. Production of the coins turned out to be unfeasible, and the city transferred the designs to manhole covers. Four of the six designs are now in 40 downtown locations. Just look down!

## ART IN CITY HALL:

With the election of a new Mayor came the idea to showcase the work of local artists in City Hall's council chambers. The exhibit of loaned works of art, which will rotate annually, features work by five photographers and one visual artist this year. The work will be on the chamber's west wall, so just look up!
